Revised Notice for conducting U. G. 2nd, 4th & 6th Semester (Honours / Program) Examinations, 2021 and Part-II / III (Honours / General) Examinations, 2021

As directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, I am issuing a revised notice informing all concerned that:

- 1) The University has decided to provide a special chance to those candidates of U.G. CBCS system who failed to clear the 1st semester examination in three consecutive chances. Those candidates may fill-in the examination forms of 2nd and 4th (if they have any back papers) and 6th Semester examination, 2021.
- 2) The above candidates shall appear for their 1st semester when the odd semester examination shall take place.
- 3) The decision has been taken keeping in mind the covid-19 pandemic situation.
- 4) The portal for filling in the examination forms shall open on 15th July, 2021, 11:00 am to 16th July, 2021, 06:00 pm. in online mode at *nbuexams.net* by inserting registration number.
- 5) Other than the above mentioned category of students, the students who normally could not fill-in the U.G. even and annual part-III and part-III system examination forms on the last dates may also avail the chance.
- 6) The University has decided to conduct U. G. Even Semesters and U. G. Part-II / III Examinations, 2021 (Regular / Casual). Due to COVID-19 pandemic the conventional mode of examinations i.e. writing examinations in the examination hall in pen & paper mode has been replaced by assignment mode of examinations.
- 7) The U. G. Even Semester Examinations (under CBCS) shall commence from 22nd July, 2021 and continue till 25th July, 2021.
- 8) The U. G. Part-II / III Examinations (under 1+1+1 system) shall commence from **24th July**, **2021** and continue till **29th July**, **2021**.
- 9) The candidates may download the Admit Cards from 19th July, 2021 by inserting their registration number at *nbuexams.net*
- 10) The students will be given question papers to prepare assignments at home only. The question papers will be available at *nbuexams.net* before examinations (i.e. 12:00 noon onwards on 22th July, 2021 for CBCS and 24th July, 2021 for annual system).
- 11) The question papers shall also be available in the college member area in *nbuexams.net* and also e-mailed to all the colleges and the Heads of the Departments of Anthropology, Geology & Tea Science, University of North Bengal.

The remuneration shall be credited in their account in due time.

The appointments for evaluation and scrutiny shall be issued by the Principals / TICs' / OICs' of the colleges concerned.

N.B.: The following instructions may kindly be noted with due importance while issuing appointment letters to the examiners and pre-publication scrutinizers:

- i) All examination duties are of confidential nature. Any information related to it should not be divulged to anyone except the officials connected / related with the examination system.
- ii) The Examiners shall take independently all decisions regarding evaluation in pursuance of University Ordinances / Regulations etc. He / She should not entertain any request / pressure whatsoever in this regard. If any such situation arises, the matter should immediately be referred confidentially to the Principal / TIC / OIC for remedial measures.
- iii) If the examiners have any relative as a candidate of the examination for which they have been assigned, they are requested to bring this to the notice of the Principal / TIC / OIC with name and roll number of the candidate and should not take up the duty unless they are permitted by the Principal / TIC / OIC to do so.
- iv) Persons offering remunerative private tuitions or attached with any private coaching centres are not entitled to take up examination duties and shall not accept such duties communicating in writing about such involvements to the Principal / TIC / OIC.
